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As a tenured professor of art education with twenty-two years of professional experience, my expertise includes comprehensive curriculum design, assessment, arts advocacy, authentic instruction, community art education, and qualitative research. Routledge, a leading International academic publisher, has recognized my expertise in art education by publishing my art methods textbook *Teaching and Learning in Art Education: Cultivating Students' Potential from Pre-K Through High School* (2020). Filled with rich resources and quality artworks, I developed its framework to model exemplary practices for teaching and learning in the visual arts. Throughout my profession, I have designed scholarship, peer-reviewed writings, and creative projects to make positive differences in people's lives and prepare students for active participation in our global society. I have reviewed books for Routledge, Oxford University Press, NAEA, Rowman, and Littlefield International.
